(i) Periodic Test (10 marks):

The school conducts four periodic written tests in the entire academic year and the average of the best two is taken for 20 marks.

(ii) Written Work (5 marks):

Notebook submission as a part of internal assessment is aimed at enhancing seriousness of students towards preparing notes for the topics being taught in the classroom as well as assignments. This shall address the critical aspects of regularity, punctuality, neatness and notebook upkeep.

(iii) Subject Enrichment Activities (5 marks):

These are subject-specific application activities aimed at enrichment of the understanding and skill development. These activities are recorded internally by respective subject teachers.

Languages: Activities that equip the learner to develop effective speaking and listening skills.

Mathematics: Math lab activities and projects.

Science: Practical works / activities shall be carried out as prescribed by the CBSE curriculum

Co-Scholastic Activities:

School conducts co-curricular activities for the holistic development of the students. These activities are graded on a 3 point grading scale from A to C.
